WHAT IS PRAYER?

Simply put, communicating a message to God, it's talking to God. God speaks to us primary though the Bible and we speak to him in prayer.

WHY DO WE DO IT?

Exodus 33: 11 Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend

GOD EXPECTS US TO PRAY

Matthew 6:6 But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

WHY DO WE DO IT?

BECAUSE IT IS A BLOOD BOUGHT PRIVILEGE

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

WE HAVE NOT BECAUSE WE ASK NOT

James 4:2 You desire and do not have, so you murder. You covet and cannot obtain, so you fight and quarrel. You do not have, because you do not ask.

WE ARE THE KING'S KIDS, NOT ORPHANS

So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

WHAT IS FASTING?

THE BIBLE defines fasting as a Christian's voluntary abstinence from food for spiritual purposes. It is Christian, for fasting by a non-Christian has no eternal value since the discipline's motives and purposes are to be God-centered. Fasting is voluntary in the sense that it is not to be coerced. Fasting is more than just the ultimate crash diet for the body, it is abstinence from food for spiritual purposes.

WHAT IS FASTING?

Then the disciples of John came to him, saying, "Why do we and the Pharisees fast, but your disciples do not fast?" And Jesus said to them, "Can the wedding guests mourn as long as the bridegroom is with them? The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast.

WHAT IS FASTING?

No one puts a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment, for the patch tears away from the garment, and a worse tear is made. Neither is new wine put into old wineskins. If it is, the skins burst and the wine is spilled and the skins are destroyed. But new wine is put into fresh wineskins, and so both are preserved."

- Matthew 9:14-17

- 5. To Express Repentance and a Return to God

- 8. To Overcome Temptation and Dedicate Yourself to God
- 9. To Express Love and Worship to God
